**Notice of AIPN Student Outreach Program

We wish to recruit ten qualified students from Thai universities to participate in the AIPN Student Outreach Program during the 2009 AIPN International Conference in Bangkok, 18-21 October 2009.

Information about the Association of International Petroleum Negotiators (AIPN) may be found at <www.aipn.org>. The AIPN produces model contracts for the upstream petroleum industry, one of the most widely used being the 2002 Joint Operating Agreement. The AIPN conducts negotiation workshops to upgrade skills of both lawyers and non-lawyer negotiators for companies and host governments.

Students in the Student Outreach Program will have free access to all conference sessions and special events.

We request applications from students interested in participating in the Student Outreach Program in October 2009. Qualified students include:

- Law students who have studied petroleum or energy law, and have an interest in issues arising in contracting in the E&P industry;
- Students studying petroleum engineering or technical subjects related to petroleum and/or energy projects, who have an interest in negotiation of contracts in the E&P industry; or
- Students in MBA courses who have studied the upstream petroleum industry, and have an interest in negotiation of contracts in the E&P industry.
